

Public School Funding Alliance Guidelines for Contracting with Personnel

Programs funded by Public School Funding Alliance (“PSFA”) sometimes require new personnel positions. In most cases, the person with whom PSFA is contracting for the position is the person who has applied for funding, and the PSFA board must approve all such positions.

In the case in which an application for funding involves a new position that is not going to be filled by the person submitting the application, the following process will occur:

1. PSFA (or a designated committee) will advertise the position opening and all qualified candidates will be interviewed.
2. The PSFA board has final approval of the person who will fill the position.

PSFA aims to contract with the most qualified candidate for any position, and one of its objectives is to involve more community members in the public schools.

All new personnel with whom PSFA contracts must complete background checks, as required by Methow Valley School District, as well fulfill any other district requirements a particular position may require.

A contract with PSFA is in no way related to, does not affect, and is not affected by any past, present or future employment with Methow Valley School District. Payments to all PSFA-contracted personnel, whether or not the contractor is otherwise employed by the Methow Valley School District, are made directly by PSFA. PSFA remuneration does not in any way affect a contractor’s seniority standing, benefits or any other status within the Methow Valley School District.
